

## **Nett Winery**

The Nett Winery, located in a mixed agricultural environment of vineyards, fields and pastureland in the Pfalz region of Germany, is a minimalistic building. Comprised of two longstretched halls as well as a covered passageway, it looks like a geometric ray ready to extend across the landscape. It combines the entire production facility, shop, tasting room, storage and office as well as living space for the owners. A timber frame makes up the primary structure while a lightweight wooden outer shell envelops the massive interior construction of pumice concrete. The shell uses charred yakisugi wood panels, which give a striking esthetic appearance to the building and make it extremely durable as well. The concrete walls act as thermal storage absorbing humidity and thus contribute to the overall sustainability.
