



Upon arrival, a generously sized canopy greets visitors and leads them into the two-story entrance lobby.

The design creates a coherent organizational structure with simple routing based on two key circulation areas: the straight outpatient treatment corridor and the main visitor path to the north. Expansive glass façades give these corridors and the waiting areas an open, welcoming character.






The comb-like organization of the building volumes generates a strong visual connection with the surrounding green areas from both wards and treatment rooms.











